

'and Enoch walked with God' Genesis 5:22

Following the birth of his son, Methuselah, it seems that Enoch had a closer fellowship with God than before. Perhaps this was largely due to his knowledge of the impending judgement of God against mankind which was built into his son's name. He witnessed and experienced the increasing ungodliness around him and he determined to stay close to God and to enjoy continual, unbroken fellowship with Him.

Note that the scriptures do not say, 'God walked with Enoch'. Whilst it was true that both walked in harmony together, it was God who was prominent in the partnership; He determined the path they took, not Enoch.
