

## King of Glory

Emmaus are very pleased to be able to announce that we are now stocking the King of Glory book and DVD.

This has been produced by our colleagues in Canada. It tells the story of salvation chronologically from before Creation to the Cross. It is particularly aimed at children (but not exclusively) and is split into 15 chapters. Each chapter on the DVD is about 15 minutes which makes it ideal for those involved in children's ministry or adult gospel work. There is also a study guide available to help leaders make the most of this valuable resource.

The pictures are beautifully illustrated and the content is faithful to the Scripture record, making it a really helpful way of implanting the accurate message of the Bible into the minds of children and young people (that said, I enjoyed watching the DVD and will now be using it with our young people's work over the Autumn!)

With Christmas on the horizon this really is a lovely gift for parents / grandparents to give to children they know. The special introductory rate is £7 for the book or study guide, £6 for the DVD. (The book and DVD together are £12, and all three for £15).

## Pray for the work of God within the prison service.

We received the following from one of the prison chaplains we work with. It highlights the awful forces of evil that are active in the world but also the super-abounding grace of God who works all things together for good.

*“AM was abused as a child and has had a torrid life in and out of trouble. He is now 26. Just over two months ago he was informed on a Monday that his mother had died. Tuesday we found him hanging in his cell and cut him down and managed to revive him. Wednesday the prison guards brought him to me and we were studying the Emmaus course **“The Coming King”**. Obviously AM was not ready to meet the King but surely He had a divine appointment and something special for the lad, in the inextricable working of God’s love and the mystery of the Holy Spirit.*

*I talked to him about the Lord Jesus and he began to take part with other lads helping him. He is a level 2 reader and writer though we are beginning to see improvement. AM has come to faith and now has a Bible and is telling those who ask he is getting ready to meet the coming King.”*

*AM writes “To the churches who prayed continuously through my deepest, darkest moments in my life as I lost my mother and found the Son of God. Thank you very much for my wonderful Bible and I appreciate all the help and prayers you have done for me.”*



## New Courses for 2018

We are very pleased to report that we are on the point of releasing an additional 5 courses to our range. These are particularly aimed at children and those who have difficulty reading. Each course has an exam booklet. The one for children has puzzles and pictures to colour whilst that for adults follows the pattern of our other Emmaus courses.



These courses, with a further 7 or so to follow, together with our currently available children’s courses will allow students to cover the whole of the Old Testament, Gospels and Acts. Whilst stocks last, those who complete the full set will earn themselves a Bible, as well as the usual course certificate.

Other course titles include Joshua—God’s Soldier, Ruth—The Big Decision, The Kings of Judah and Judges.

Originally written and used by Margaret Charles in her own ministry with children, these new courses are colourfully produced and bring out lessons that are bang up to date for our society today.

## A New Series for 2018

Spread over 4 courses, “The Plain Truth” will look at 12 different subjects connected with the Christian faith. The first of these: “The Plain truth about Salvation, Prayer and Bible Study” is now ready. It has been written for those who find reading difficult or for whom



English is not their first language. We have spent time over the spring months road testing this amongst some of our students who are in such a group. As an introduction to the Christian life, these courses are intended to form the basis for our students to go on and delve deeper into the Word of God. If you know of people who would benefit from
